

ALAN KEZIS COLLEGE OF NATURAL SCIENCES, FORESTRY, AND AGRICULTURE STUDENT EMERGENCY FUND

The <u>Alan Kezis College of Natural Sciences</u>, Forestry, and Agriculture Student Emergency <u>Fund</u> was established at the University of Maine Foundation in 2015 for the benefit of the University of Maine, Orono, Maine, with gifts from family, colleagues and friends of College of Natural Sciences, Forestry, and Agriculture Associate Dean Alan S. Kezis upon his retirement.

The principal shall be invested in the general endowment pool and both principal and income shall be used to provide emergency assistance for undergraduate students majoring in the College of Natural Sciences, Forestry, and Agriculture (or its successor entity) in need of short-term immediate financial assistance, including housing, heating and/or utilities assistance, medical and/or dental expenses, books, clothing or other expenses for which the student has no other source of funds. Preference will be given for students in good academic standing.

Should it ever become impossible or impractical to carry out the purposes of this fund as described above, an alternative purpose which best fits the donors' intent and wishes shall be designated by the Board of Directors of the University of Maine Foundation in its sole discretion after consulting with the President of the University of Maine and the Dean of the College of Natural Sciences, Forestry, and Agriculture.

Selection of the recipients shall be made by the Associate Dean of the College of Natural Sciences, Forestry, and Agriculture in consultation with the Dean of the College and the Office of Student Financial Aid. The fund shall be administered by the Office of Student Financial Aid.
